Lucky Country Shiraz

Produced by the Two Hands winery located in the Barossa Valley of Southern Australia. The company was formed in 1999 when two friends got together with one clear objective in mind, to create the best possible Shiraz based wines from the Shiraz producing regions in Australia.

Michael Twelftree, initially from a construction background, spent a number of years exporting Australian wine to the USA and Asia. While Richard Mintz, a chartered accountant, was formally the CEO of one of Australia's leading cooperages in the Barossa Valley. With Twelftree's contacts and wine savvy approach and Mintz's management skills, the two old friends decided to make some wine together.

And unlike many business ventures started between friends, since its opening, Two Hands has collected numerous accolades defining the culture of the organization. Two Hands Wines were listed in the *Wine Spectator* Top 100 for the last seven years with two listings in the top 10. Consistent 90+ reviews are further testament to the company's ability to achieve their objective.

Tangley Oaks Chardonnay

The label on the Tangley Oaks wines symbolizes the majesty of California's native oak trees. Much like these grand trees, the grape varieties selected for Tangley Oaks wines represent the legacy of California wine-making.

The success of the current California wine boom has been a saga unique to America in its complex combination of politics, entrepreneurship, science and unforeseen acts of God. Sometime around 1780 missionaries first planted grapes in California. After America annexed California in 1847, vineyards spread north throughout the state. Then in 1880, a disease destroyed the vines and with them the wine industry. Just as California's wine industry began to recuperate, prohibition struck, and by the end of WWII, there were less than 120 wineries in the state.

Worldwide recognition did not come until fairly recently. Many believe that the return of the same disease from the 1880's in 1980, and the resulting need to replant nearly all of the vineyards in the Napa Valley and Sonoma, should be credited with the unsurpassed quality found in California wines today.

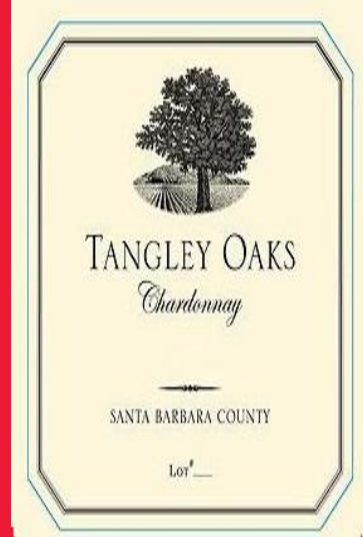
